Frequently Asked Questions for Parents and YW

When is Camp?

June 22, 2021 - June 24, 2021

We will have a “day camp” style Girls Camp this year. There will be no overnight camping, however each day will have lots of fun and new adventures and activities.

YCLs and Stake Leaders will set-up camp on **Monday, June 21**

Where is Camp?

Camp Burnett will be our homebase for camp this year. However, we will go to two other locations throughout the camp. Each young woman and parents will be given an exact schedule to know where we will be at all times.

Directions from Stake Center to Camp Burnett:

Camp Burnett is about 18 miles West of Carrollton. Suggested route is South on Sam Rayburn Tollway. Use left 3 lanes to continue on SH 114 in Grapevine. Exit White Chapel Blvd
Exit White Chapel Blvd
Turn Right on White Chapel Blvd heading North for 1.4 miles
Take 2nd exit on Roundabout - continuing North
You will see Camp Burnett on your Right (just after Wingate Ln)

What are YW camp registration costs and deadlines?

The cost of YW camp in 2021 will be **\$55** for members of the Carrollton Stake.

Cost for participants not in our stake is **\$75**.

***Online Registration paperwork is due on or before Sunday, May 2, 2021. ONCE ONLINE REGISTRATION CLOSES YOU WILL NO LONGER BE ABLE TO REGISTER FOR GIRLS CAMP. NO EXCEPTIONS. Your YW president, ward camp director and clerk will determine when camp payments are due.** All camp payments should be submitted through your Bishopric using tithing slips, mark the “Other” section and write “YW Camp.”

We encourage young women to earn their own money individually to pay for camp fees. Parents are encouraged to help their YW in this endeavor and discuss with ward leaders regarding fundraising opportunities. (Parents should talk with your ward’s YW President or Bishop if they have any questions or concerns about YW camp fees.)

Each YW will need to complete the following “paperwork” online:

- Registration and Parental Consent Form
- Medical Information Form (including picture of current immunizations)
- Participation Contract

Who is eligible to attend YW Camp?

The YW Camp program is designed to serve the young women from the year they turn 12 through the summer after their junior year in high school. This year, graduating Seniors also have the option to attend camp if they would like.

We no longer have Levels at camp. However, the girls will occasionally be divided into age or ward groups. These age groups *may* include:

- Year born
- Grade in School
- Middle School (or younger) Group/High School Group/YCLs

**As always, we want the girls to feel comfortable and included while at camp. Ward Camp Leaders are encouraged to advocate for the girls in their ward so that we can help all YW receive the best possible experience at camp.*

Why are we not having overnight camp?

Our Area Authority has asked us not to have overnight camp because of COVID-19. Our stake has chosen to follow this admonition, and will instead do a “Day Camp” style camp.

Behavior standards at camp – (see online camp participation contract)

Every young woman attending camp is expected to dress and behave in a manner consistent with church standards. We expect each young woman to respect the property of the camp facility, and other participants at camp. We also expect that each young woman will be respectful in her demeanor, language and actions to adults and other young women. Her actions should reflect in every way that she is a daughter of God. Specific dress code requirements are listed at the top of the packing list.

Cell phones at camp

Cell phones and other electronic music and media devices are **not permitted at camp**. YW camp is intended to be an experience where the young women get away from the influences of the world. As such, we ask that these items be left at home. If you have a specific need to contact your daughter during the week, you can make arrangements to communicate with your daughter through your ward

camp leader. Any phones that are brought to camp accidentally or intentionally will be collected and given to their specific ward leader for safekeeping each morning and returned at the end of day.

Can I invite my friend who is not a member of the church?

Yes! We would love to have your friends join us at girls camp this year. All of the same rules and regulations apply, and the same paperwork is required for these participants. **Cost will be \$75.**

What is the camp policy about prescription medication?

If possible, please take medications in the mornings and evenings when at home. Any prescription medication that **must** be taken during the day will be given to the camp nurse upon arrival at YW Camp. All medications should be in their original bottles. The camp nurse will oversee and administer all prescription medications at camp.

**Over the counter medications will be administered only with prior authorization by a parent/guardian (see online Medical Information Form).*

What else should I bring to camp with me?

Can I bring snacks to camp with me?

Sure! We will provide food for **all evening meals** and **two lunches**. We will also provide **lots of snacks** each day in addition to water stations that will be available at the various activities each day. However, if you still want to bring snacks for you and your friends, you are welcome to do so.

All snacks should be kept in sealed ziploc containers/bags to prevent ants from finding your food.
