

Carrollton Stake YW Camp 2022: Camp Victory

Frequently Asked Questions for YW and Parents

Where/When is Camp?

YCLs and Stake Leaders will depart from the stake center on **Monday, 27 June 2022**

1st - 4th Year YW and Ward Camp Leaders will depart from the stake center on **Tuesday, 28 June 2022**

We will break camp at approximately 11:00 AM on **Friday, 1 July 2022**

Directions from Stake Center:

Camp Victory is about 76 miles NE of Carrollton. Suggested route is **North on Sam Rayburn Tollway** for about 20 miles. Use right 2 lanes to merge onto **US-75N** toward Sherman.

Take **Exit 72** toward TX-91. Turn **left** onto **N State Highway 91/TX-91** (Crossing into **Oklahoma**).

Turn **left** on **E2180 Rd** and almost immediately **turn right** on **Willafa Woods Rd**. Continue to drive straight North until road ends in a T. Camp Victory (located on 1st Ave) will be on your left.

What are YW camp registration costs and deadlines?

The cost for camp is **\$210 per participant**.

- **Online Registration Forms** are due on or before **Sunday, May 15, 2022**. **Registration will close after this date.**
- Registration forms will be submitted through the youth website, **carrolltonstakeyouth.com**. All YW payments should be submitted to your wards and not the stake.

We encourage young women to earn their own money individually to pay for camp fees. Parents are encouraged to help their YW in this endeavor. (Parents should talk with your ward's YW President or Bishop if they have any questions or concerns about YW camp fees.)

The Carrollton Stake does not organize or participate in fundraising activities for YW camp as a stake. Wards who wish to organize and participate in fundraising activities should consult with the Church handbook of instructions for fundraising regulations. Fundraising activities require the authorization of a Bishop, and can only be organized to support one activity per year.

Ward t-shirts, apparel, or swag along with transportation and any other expenses specific to an individual ward must come out of the individual ward budgets. Please consult your Bishop with specific budget questions.

Registration Forms

Forms will be available on the stake youth website and will be live as of **April 14, 2022**

Each YW camper will complete:

- Registration Form/Code of Conduct (online)
- Medical Information and Release (online)
- Copy of current immunizations (if not on file)
- Camp Fees paid to Ward

Who is eligible to attend YW Camp?

The YW Camp program is designed to serve the young women from the year they turn 12 through the summer after their junior year in high school.

Level breakdowns are as follows:

Level 1 – 11 year olds who are turning 12 this year as well as young women entering 7th grade

Level 2 – young women entering 8th grade

Level 3 – young women entering 9th grade

Level 4 – young women entering 10th grade

Levels 5 & 6 (YCLs) – young women entering 11th and 12th grades

*Discussion among parents, Bishops and YW leaders is appropriate in cases that do not neatly fall into one of the above categories to determine what is best for the young woman using the outlined guidelines as the general rule.

Behavior standards at camp – (see camp participation contract)

Every young woman attending camp is expected to dress and behave in a manner consistent with church standards. We expect each young woman to respect the property of the camp facility and other participants at camp. We also expect that each young woman will be respectful in her demeanor, language and actions to adults and other young women. Specific dress code guidelines and behavioral expectations will be included in the Camp Code of Conduct found in the Registration Form.

Cell phones at camp

Cell phones and other electronic music and media devices are **not permitted at camp** (ipad, computers, etc). YW camp is intended to be an experience where the young women get away from the influences of the world. As such, we ask that these items be left at home. If you need to contact your daughter(s) during the week, you can make arrangements to communicate through ward camp leaders. Any phones that are brought to camp accidentally or intentionally will be collected and given to their specific ward leader for safekeeping until camp breaks on Friday.

Can I invite my friend who is not a member of the church?

YES! We would love to have friends of other faiths attend our camp. This is a great opportunity to Love, Share and Invite. The Cost of Camp remains at \$210 per participant, and they will fill out all registration forms online just like all other participants.

What is the camp policy about prescription medications?

Any prescription medication must be given to the camp nurse upon arrival at YW Camp. All medications should be in their original bottles. These medications will be securely locked in a medicine cabinet, and will be administered by the Camp Nurse. Over the counter medications will be administered only with prior authorization by a parent/guardian (see camp registration forms).

What will the sleeping arrangements be?

Camp Victory is a beautiful facility with air-conditioned cabins with their own bathroom equipped with 2 showers, 2 toilets and 2 sinks in each cabin. The girls will be sleeping on bunk beds **with their ward**. YCLs will be sleeping in their own cabin with Stake Leaders.

What else should I bring to camp with me?

Can I bring snacks to camp with me?

We will be providing food for three meals a day and an evening dessert. In addition, we will have a snack station available throughout the day.

The food provided will be adequate, and you do not *need* to bring any other food. However, if you *wish* to bring your own snacks, please remember that **all snacks should be kept in sealed Ziploc containers/bags to prevent ants and racoons from finding your food. Coordinate food with your Ward Camp Leaders, as you may wish to keep all Ward food in a cooler.**

Food At Camp

Unfortunately, Camp Victory is not able to provide Gluten Free Meals. However, there is a refrigerator and space available in the kitchen to store food. Once we know all allergies and meal restrictions, we will reach out to specific Ward Leaders and YW to coordinate those meals.

Schedule

We begin our day bright and early usually about 7:30 AM. The YW rotate through a variety of activities as levels, wards, or YW classes. We all join together for evening programs. On the first day of camp, each YW will receive a schedule for the week. These schedules will be stored behind their name tag on their lanyard for reference throughout the day.
